Policy Updates

A policy memo has been released noting an increase to the current Procurement Thresholds. Per USDA Food and Nutrition Services, the current Micro-Purchase Threshold has been increased from \$3,500 to \$10,000. The Simplified Acquisition Threshold (SAT) has been increased from \$150,000 to \$250,000. In lieu of these changes, please update your current Procurement Policy, unless your organization's purchasing practices are more restrictive.
