• 2016 GFBA Grant Available •

The Georgia Food Bank Association (GFBA) is seeking request for proposals (RFPs) for the GFBA - 2016 Capital and Community Investment Grants. Grants between \$3,000 and \$10,000 will be awarded to organizations to be used for capital investment purchases/expenses. Awards will be granted to organizations that meet any or all of the following criteria:

- 1. Providing year round feeding (both summer and afterschool),
- 2. Summer feeding only, or
- 3. Afterschool feeding only.

Eligible applicants must be:

- Experienced providers in the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and/or the At-Risk Afterschool component of the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP);
- In good standing with Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning; and/or
- Organizations with existing viable backpack programs that want to expand their services.

The deadline to apply is March 4, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.

Application Submission Requirements



DECAL encourages sponsors to complete and submit the SFSP application at least 45 days prior to the start of summer meal service and no later than June 15, 2016 to ensure adequate time for DECAL to review the application.

Failure to submit a complete application by the deadline date will delay review and approval of the application. Release of DECAL's GA ATLAS System

DECAL's GA ATLAS (Access, Training and Learning Application System) is up and running. SFSP sponsors will experience a more user-friendly system that will allow 1) access to training registration and webinar or webbased training sessions 2) one application for CACFP and SFSP 3) claims submission and processing, and 4) the compliance review system.

GA ATLAS is available to new and experienced SFSP sponsors as of January 1, 2016. Annual training requirements for FY 2016 include attendance and completion of renewal training for experienced sponsors (1-day session) or Program and Orientation training for new sponsors (2-day session) and the "How to Complete the Application in GA ATLAS" training session. Sponsors must complete all training requirements in order to receive access to the GA ATLAS system. SFSP sponsors will have the opportunity to view web-based tutorial sessions that provide an introduction to navigating through GA ATLAS prior to completing required training.

"How to Complete the Application in GA ATLAS" training dates are listed below. Registration is now open. To register, contact Leslie Truman at 404.657.1779. Seating is limited. Therefore, sponsors are encouraged to register for training as soon as possible. (Note: training sessions are half-day.)
