## Minutes

On November 4, 2021, the Cross-Agency Child Council (CACC) for the Preschool Development Grant, Birth through Five (PDG B-5), facilitated by Carl Vinson Institute of Government staff was called to order at 1:00 pm by Deputy Commissioner Susan Adams.

The meeting began with updates given by Deputy Commissioners Bentley Ponder and Elisabetta Kasfir with the Department of Early Care and Learning (DECAL), Carmen Calloway with the Division of Family and Children Services (DFCS), and Caitlin Dooley with the Department of Education (DOE). Then, Deputy Commissioner Susan Adams gave an overview of PDG B-5 updates and linkages to the Children's Cabinet presentation.

David Tanner with the Carl Vinson Institute of Government (Institute of Government) introduced the Cross-Agency Child Data System (CACDS) as a critical project for the CACC.

Deputy Commissioner Ponder, Laura Wagner with DECAL, and Amy Smigielski presented about Georgia's CACDS. Deputy Commissioner Ponder reviewed the alignment of CACDS with PDG B-5 goals. Ms. Wagner reviewed participating programs with CACDS. Ms. Smigielski shared the CACDS research agenda and identified potentially relevant projects.

Mr. Tanner then facilitated the feedback discussion regarding the localized data and visualization strategies using the digital platform Mural.

Sean Mack with the Department of Public Health presented on Georgia's Women, Infant, and Children (WIC) program.

Director of the Infant and Early Childhood Mental Health (IECMH) program at the Department of Early Care and Learning, Laura Lucas, presented about the IECMH task force.

Deputy Commissioner Adams and Dr. Melinda Moore then thanked the Council members for their insights and time discussing feedback for the PDG B-5 and goal areas for the next year.
