

What is the Core Knowledge Preschool Sequence?

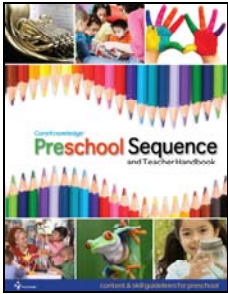
The **Core Knowledge Preschool Sequence** is a preschool curriculum based on the latest research in early childhood education. The curriculum presents explicitly sequenced content and skill guidelines and developmentally appropriate practices for the education of young children. Only by specifying the competencies and knowledge that all children should share can we guarantee equal access to those competencies and knowledge. The specificity of the skills that comprise each learning goal helps teachers to create, implement, and assess instructional activities that meet the needs of individual children. Oral language support is also a hallmark of the *Preschool Sequence* and provides a strong foundation for formal written literacy skills.

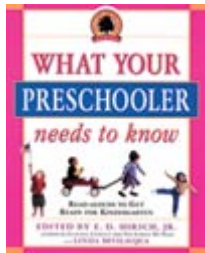
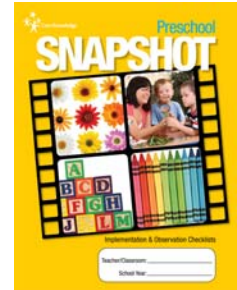

- **Best Practices** for each developmental domain.
- **Explicitly stated learning goals** for each developmental domain.
 - Learning goals are further defined by one or more **individual skills** that have been defined for two levels of learner. The specificity of these skills and the inclusion of level I and level II skills support teachers as they address the individual needs of children three- to five-years-old.
- **Language of Instruction** for each developmental domain. These are the terms that knowledgeable and competent individuals generally use to talk about the particular subject area. These terms allow teachers to use and model language to help children develop vocabulary skills.
- **Cross-Curricular Connections** that demonstrate how skills and content from each developmental domain can be presented and reinforced in conjunction with skills and content from other developmental domains.
- The most important ideas for each developmental domain are presented in a quick-reference **At a Glance** box.
- Specific **Oral Language Skills** presented within each developmental domain.
- Background knowledge and **teaching ideas** that support **What Teachers Need to Know** to ensure that classroom activities and experiences meet the needs of individual children and address the content, goals, and skills necessary for children's success.
- **Scaffolding Strategies** specific to each developmental domain.
- **Assessment Strategies** for each developmental domain, highlighting what to look for and when to look.
- **Resource Lists** for both children and teachers.

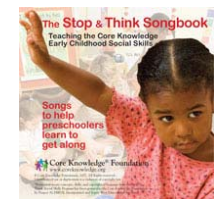
