Phonological Awareness

Jump up and Sit down Beginning Sounds Game

Explain these rules to your child, “If I say two words that begin with the same sound (the emphasis is on the sound not the letter), you will jump up as quickly as possible.

If the words do not begin with the same sound, you will sit down, or remain sitting.

Possible Word Pairs: butterfly/bumblebee, spider/ladybug, moth/mantis, caterpillar/ant, beetle/bug, grasshopper/fly

Literacy

Read [The Very Grouchy Ladybug](#). After reading, ask your child, “Can you think of a time you were grouchy? How did you feel? What made you feel better? How could you help other people feel better when they are grouchy?”

Science

Listen to [The Handwasher Song](#). Talk with your child about the importance of washing hands to wash away germs (germs make us sick). Handwashing keeps us healthy and safe. Talk with your child about when they should wash their hands (before/after eating, after using the restroom, after playing outside). Have your child practice washing his hands either singing the handwasher song or singing the ABC song (20 seconds).

Writing

Mystery Letter Game

Have your child turn around so her back is facing you. Slowly write a letter on her back using your finger. Have her guess the letter you wrote. After your child guesses the correct letter, turn around and let your child practice writing a letter on your back and you try to guess what she wrote. Continue to do this until your child loses interest. Make it a fun game by involving other members of the family.
