Phonological Awareness

Insect Syllable Challenge: Clap out syllables in insect words.

Insect Words: moth, insect, caterpillar, spider, stinkbug, ladybug, grasshopper, bumblebee

Challenge your child to think of more words related to insects and determine how many syllables each word has.

Literacy

Read [The Very Hungry Caterpillar](#) by Eric Carle. While reading, have your child predict what the caterpillar will eat next. What happened to the caterpillar to give him a stomachache? Have you ever had a stomachache? How did you feel? What made you feel better? After reading, talk with your child about what happened to the caterpillar and the life cycle of a butterfly (butterfly, egg, caterpillar, chrysalis).

Math

Have your child pick 5 items from her room to measure. Go outside and help her collect items she sees in nature that could be used for measurement (blades of grass, stones, leaves). Have your child measure the items from her room using the items found in nature. Ask your child: How many leaves long is it? How many stones long? Which object is the longest? Which is the shortest? How can you tell?

Fine Motor

Uh Oh! Sally the Caterpillar does not want to come out of her chrysalis. Have your child draw a picture/write a letter to Sally to convince her to come out! Reasons might include, exciting things to eat, fun activities to do together, or interesting places to go. Encourage your child to be as persuasive as possible!
