On the Move

Apple Hop

Hop around the apples!

Materials:

- Paper
- Crayons/Markers
- Scissors
- Tape
- Music

Instructions:

1. Trace and cut apples from paper. Encourage your child to decorate/color the apples.
2. Tape the apples in a circle on the floor, with a short amount of distance in between each of them.
3. Instruct your child to hop from one apple to the next as you play their favorite songs.

Apple Hunt

The apples are hiding. Where could they be?

Materials:

- Real, plastic or paper apples.
- Bin
- Shredded or torn paper

Instructions:

1. Place apples in bin. If you do not have any apples, create paper apples by crumbling up red or green paper.
2. Add shredded or torn paper to cover the apples.
3. Encourage your child to dig through the paper to find the apples.

Paper Bag Apple

This fun craft activity is the perfect masterpiece to hang in your home.

Materials:

- Paper bag
- Crayons/Markers
- Paper/Construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Draw an outline of an apple on your paper bag. Make sure the apple outline fits the size of your paper bag.
2. Cut out the apple outline and color your apple red or green.
3. Create a stem and leaves out for your apple and glue them to your apple.
4. Admire the "Paper Bag Apple" and find a place in your home to hang your child's masterpiece.
