On the Move

Dino Dance

It's time to stomp around and dance like a dinosaur!

Materials:

- Empty tissue boxes
- Paper
- Tape
- Crayons/markers

Instructions:

1. Cover the empty tissue boxes in paper and decorate as desired.
2. Cut triangles and glue them to the top of the box (for toenail claws).
3. Have your toddler slip their feet into the boxes.
4. Play music and encourage your child to stomp around like a dinosaur!

Who wants to be an archeologist? Let's use the sandbox to look for fossils.

Materials:

- Bin
- Sand
- Plastic toy dinosaurs
- Paint brushes, tooth brushes or similar utensils

Instructions:

1. Place dinosaurs in the bin.
2. Cover the dinosaurs with sand.
3. Have your child use the paint brush or tooth brush to reveal the dinosaurs they find in the sand.
4. Count how many dinosaurs you and your toddler uncover.
