

## Farm Activities for Monday

### On the Move

#### Milk the Cow

This fun, fine motor activity helps your toddler understand where their milk comes from.

#### Materials:

- Latex Glove
- Water
- Tape
- Dining Chair
- Black Marker
- Large Bowl

#### Instructions:

1. Draw cow spots on both sides of the glove.
2. Fill the glove with water and tie the opening securely.
3. Tape the tied end of the glove to the bottom of a dining chair and place the bowl directly under the glove.
4. Poke small holes into the “udders” using a thumb tack or needle.
5. Have your toddler gently pull the udders to release the water into the bowl.

### Sensory Time

#### Tractor Wash

Farming is hard work. Let's help the farmer wash his tractors.

#### Materials:

- 2 Bins
- Dirt
- Water
- Soap
- Paint brushes
- Variety of farm equipment

#### Instructions:

1. Put dirt on one bin and add a small amount of water to make mud.
2. Add tear free soap and water to the other bin.
3. Let children play with the equipment in the mud.
4. Then let them wash them in the soapy water using the paint brush.

## Arts and Creativity

### Muddy Piggies!

Your child will have fun making muddy piggies with these sensory art ideas!

Materials:

- Mud
- Paper Plate
- Water
- Bowl
- Marker

Instructions:

1. Draw a pig nose in the middle of the paper plate, and two eyes.
2. Get some dirt from outside and mix it with water until it is the consistency of paint.
3. Talk to your child about how pigs need mud to cool them off. Ask your child if the mud feels cool.
4. Now it's time to fingerpaint the mud paint on the pig!

\*Modification:

If you would prefer that your child not paint with mud, you can mix shaving cream with brown paint for this activity
