On the Move

Tree Bowling

Tumble over trees in this fun bowling game.

Materials:

- Toilet paper tubes
- Paper
- Crayons/Markers
- Small ball
- Glue/Tape

Instructions:

1. Cut tree top shapes from paper & color and decorate as desired.
2. Tape or glue the treetops to the top of the tubes.
3. Arrange the tubes together in a group.
4. Provide your child with the ball and ask them to roll it and knock over as many pins as possible.

See what happens to the leaves while singing this finger play

Five Little Leaves

Five little leaves on the tree next door, *(hold up five fingers)*

One fell off and then there were four. *(hold up four fingers)*

Four little leaves all over the tree, *(hold up four fingers)*

A bird pulled off one and then there were three. *(hold up three fingers)*

Three little leaves where the wind blew, *(hold up three fingers)*

One fell off and then there were two. *(hold up two fingers)*

Two little leaves sitting in the sun, *(hold up two fingers)*

A bug ate it and now there is one. *(hold up one finger)*

One little leaf in the tree all alone, *(hold up one finger)*

The wind blew and blew and now there are none!
