On the Move

Umbrella Toss

Grab an umbrella and soft toys for a fun game of toss.

Materials:

- Umbrella
- Soft toys, small balls, or bean bags

Instructions:

1. Open an umbrella and place on the floor, upside down.
2. Provide your toddler with the soft toys/small balls/bean bags and instruct them to throw the items into the umbrella.
3. Ask your child to identify the colors of the soft toys, small balls or bean bags as they toss them.

Sensory Time

It's Raining!

Playing in the rain is a great way to cool off from the summer heat.

Materials:

- Large bin
- Watering can/Plastic cups with holes poked in them
- Water

Instructions:

1. Put water in the bin.
2. Add watering cans or cups with holes poked in them.
3. Pour water from the watering cans into the bin to watch it rain into the bin.
4. If using plastic cups with holes poked in them, dip the plastic cup into the bin and watch the water sprinkle through the holes in the cups.

Arts and Creativity

Weather Mobile Craft

Let's create a beautiful weather symbol mobile with toddler's very own artwork

Materials:

- A Stick or hanger (you will need something to hang your weather symbols from)
- Crayons, markers or paint
- String & tape
- Paper

Instructions:

1. Draw weather symbols on your paper using your markers, crayons etc. Your toddler can draw a rainbow, rainclouds, some raindrops, lightning, and sun.
2. Cut your weather symbols out.
3. Tape each weather symbol to the string.
4. Tie the weather symbols onto different locations of your stick or hanger to create a weather mobile.
5. Ask your toddler where she/he would like to hang their mobile & revisit your weather mobile daily to talk about the weather of the day.
