#### Spring Bunny Color Hop

Materials:

- Colored paper

Instructions:

3. Tape the paw prints closely together along a cleared path in your home.
4. Encourage your child to hop like a bunny from one color to the next.
5. Have your child identify the colors as they hop from paw to paw.

## **Arts and Creativity**

### **My Very Own Weather and Seasons Book**

The idea of a toddler being an author/ illustrator is awesome, so let's make our own book on Weather and Seasons!

Materials:

- Any type of paper, construction paper, paper bags, etc.
- Crayons or markers

Instructions:

1. Find a way to place at least 5-6 pages together to make a book. You can staple the sheets together on the side or at a corner, punch holes in the along the side of the paper or glue the sides together. (Suggestion: Ask your toddler how they want to make their book stay together and ask them would they like to make a book on weather, four seasons or both)
2. Brainstorm with your child about all the different types of weather (sun, rain, wind, & snow) & the four seasons (spring, summer, winter & fall)
3. Now let your illustrator start creating their book. Don't forget your cover/title page! Each page will have either a picture of the weather or a season.  
(Example: page 1 is a picture of the sun, page 2 is a picture of the rain, etc.)
4. Label your toddlers picture on each page with the weather or season used in the picture.  
(Example: sun, fall, winter, or if you have it, add a picture of them in the rain.)
5. After making your book, let your toddler read their book to you!
