



BATHROOM SUPERVISION

Stay close. Stay engaged.
Keep children safe.



Remain present and attentive to actively supervise and assist children as needed.

Ensure only one child uses single use bathrooms and/or stalls at a time. Waiting children should remain engaged elsewhere until it is their turn.

Provide steps when needed to help children safely and easily access the toilet and sink. Make toilet paper and liquid soap readily accessible for use, so children have no wait time when completing the routine.

Prevent problems before they occur by positively guiding children to safe choices and keeping them on task. Ensure other children respect their privacy while using the toilet.

Stay engaged to interact with the children during the routine. Teach children proper handwashing steps and remind them to lather for 20 seconds before rinsing.
