OVERVIEW

Beyond Centers & Circle Time is a play-based curriculum substantiated by research and grounded in the theories of Vygotsky, Piaget, Freud, and Erikson. It examines the development of the child engaged in the three types of play—sensorimotor, structured construction, and dramatic play—from ages birth through five. The curriculum provides early educators with knowledge of how to embed cognitive and social/emotional skills and knowledge in children's play, assess children's development through their play behaviors, and how to plan and arrange rich developmentally appropriate experiences. While many curricula focus on memorization of alphabet and number knowledge, this curriculum provides early educators with knowledge of why play should be the vehicle for early learning and how to use research based scales to assess children's development.
