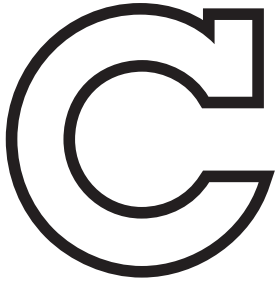


Happy CACFP Week!
