Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning Commissioner Amy M. Jacobs Introduces New Statewide Choking Prevention Campaign

What:

To celebrate the launch of its new statewide *Chop*, *Look*, *Listen* choking prevention campaign, the **Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (DECAL)** will conduct two special media events.

The live events will unveil the new choking prevention campaign, demonstrate food safety fundamentals, and provide essential information to help protect Georgia's children from the preventable danger of choking during mealtimes.

Why:

On average, a child dies every five days in the United States from choking on food, with children under age 3 at the greatest risk. Young children have an increased risk of choking because their windpipes are narrower (about the diameter of a drinking straw) than an adult's. Choking hazards exist; however, even after a child reaches the age where they are more experienced at feeding themselves. Types of food play a role, and certain characteristics, like shape, size, and texture, increase the potential for choking.
