

Federal Reporting Data 2021 fiscal year (October 1, 2020- – September 30, 2021)

Beginning October 1, 2018 the Lead Agency’s definition of serious injury is defined for licensed providers as:

A death or an incident requiring hospitalization or professional medical attention other than first aid of a child while in the care of the provider that that was the result of a substantiated intentional or gross negligent act on behalf of the provider and or staff that indicates a deficiency in the operation and or management of the program. Any case of serious injury that was substantiated by the Lead Agency will be deemed as Extreme Harm and Imminent Danger according to the Lead Agency's Integrated Enforcement and Compliance System.
