Farm to School (F2S) and Farm to Early Care and Education Month Education (FTECE) programs represent an innovative opportunity to address some of the most critical issues facing Georgia through a comprehensive approach that seeks to improve child nutrition, thus improving academic performance and providing local market opportunities for Georgia farmers.

Georgia agencies, schools, early care and education (ECE) providers, parents, students, farmers, and communities are collaborating to implement F2S and FTECE programs to increase access and education around fresh, local, and nutritious foods to support healthy growth & development. - (3) children color cards, then try to flip over matching cards.


Teachers will need to print and cut the cards out. If children are old enough, allow them to cut the cards out for this year's compaign to access other activities and
