

# **Payments** 2021 - 2022

- Pre-K payments will be processed by the 14<sup>th</sup> of each month or the next business day.
- The August and September payments will be based on the Grant Agreement.
- The October payment will be based on Roster 1 data.
  - Roster 1 data will be reviewed to determine proration of operating costs.
  - It is very important that Roster data is entered correctly and on time.

# Staffing the classroom





- Each Pre-K classroom should be staffed with a credentialed lead and assistant teacher.
  - Review Pre-K Guidelines for credentials.
  - Multiple options for meeting the credential requirement
  - Assistant teacher age requirement of 21 removed in current guidelines.
- Due to the pandemic, many programs are struggling to find teachers with the appropriate credential.
  - Work with your higher education programs to identify appropriate candidates
  - Post open positions on DECAL website
  - Consider delaying the start of school
  - Apply for a credential waiver



## **Applying for a Credential Waiver**

- Providers that are unable to fill a lead and/or assistant teacher position with a sufficiently credentialed teacher can request a waiver of teacher credential.
- Classes without a sufficiently credentialed lead teacher are paid at the insufficient credential rate, which is equal to the assistant teacher salary.
  - The insufficient rate will not be applied if the waivered lead teacher has a verified ECE Associate Degree. These class will be paid at the Two-Year Degree rate.
- Waivered lead teachers are not eligible for the CYE supplement.
- Request for Waiver of Teacher Credential form will be posted under the Project Director Resource List.
  - Submit the form to your Pre-K Specialist for review and approval.

## **Employment Terms Document**

- Beginning in school year 2021-2022, all Pre-K grantees are required to have written documentation detailing the employment terms between the employer and all Georgia's Pre-K lead teachers. This written documentation is recommended, but not required, for Pre-K assistant teachers.
- The employment terms document should include the following, at a minimum:
  - Employment beginning and end dates
  - Compensation information
  - Benefits information
  - Broad scope of work
- Refer to Section 11. 3 of the Pre-K Providers' Operating Guidelines for details.
  - Appendix Z Sample Georgia's Pre-K At-Will Employment Agreement provides guidance in developing written documentation detailing the employment terms between the employer and all Georgia's Pre-K lead teachers.
- If your program already uses an employment terms document (employment contract, offer letter, work agreement, etc.), the document will meet the requirement.

## **Work Sampling Online (WSO)**

- Teachers are required to rate each student on ALL performance indicators.
  - Only required to collect assessment documentation for the Language and Literacy and Mathematical Thinking domains.
  - Teachers should also collect documentation in the social emotional domain for any children who are experiencing challenging behaviors.
- Work Sampling Online training will be embedded throughout New Teacher Training.
- Webinars will be offered for new and returning teachers.
- Webinar for Administrators will be offered in the fall.
- WSO portal opens:
  - July 20<sup>th</sup> administrators
  - August 10<sup>th</sup> teachers

# Pre-K Visits 2021 - 2022

#### **Program and Roster Verification Visits**

- Will begin after September 13<sup>th</sup> (first roster).
- Visits will be scheduled for a mutually agreed upon time and day.
- Providers will be contacted by their assigned Pre-K Specialist to:
  - Schedule the visit
  - Discuss information required for the visit
  - Provide a list of any documents that should be uploaded to PANDA or emailed to the specialist prior to the visit

# Pre-K Training



- Annual training is required for lead teachers, assistant teachers, and NEW directors.
- New teachers will need to register for Virtual Live sessions this fall (2 days).
  - Virtual live means that teachers must participate in-person during the session.
- Returning teachers have several options:
  - Virtual live
  - Self-paced online
  - Face to face (after January)
- New directors will register for virtual live or self-paced sessions.

## **Teacher Training**

- The Pre-K Teacher Training Guide is posted.
  - New Teacher Training (2 days)
    - Virtual live trainings
  - Returning Teachers (1 day) can choose from:
    - Virtual live training
    - Self-paced training
    - Face to face training (beginning in January)
- An email will be sent when training registration opens.
- Training sessions begin on August 24<sup>th</sup>.



## **New Director Training**

2021 - 2022

New Director training offered by virtual live sessions or self-paced sessions.

- **Pre-K Basics:** This training will focus on the *Pre-K Providers' Operating Guidelines*.
- **Supporting a Quality Pre-K Program:** This training will focus on the Grant Requirement Checklist and program monitoring.
- **Pre-K Financial Basics:** Topics include financial and accounting responsibilities, expenditure requirements, record keeping, and reporting requirements.
- **Georgia's Pre-K Year End Reconciliation Report:** Topics include completing the 2021-2022 Reconciliation Report and supporting documentation providers must maintain.
- WSO for Administrators: This training will walk through the steps of Work Sampling and how administrators can screen teacher classes to support them.




#### OTAGS
