INDOOR HAZARDS

Staff are aware of hazards and take preventative measures








INDOOR HAZARDS

an item easily reached by a child or an area that can be easily entered by a child





ACTIVE SUPERVISION

Supervise children by sight and sound during all routines, diapering, toileting, feeding, napping and indoor play







ACTIVE SUPERVISION

Program management is responsible for ensuring staff are aware of expectations for supervision








Items marked "keep out of the reach of children" are inaccessible







Closets and cabinets where hazardous items are stored should be locked









Personal items should be kept in a space inaccessible to children














Children's bags are checked for hazards







Plants are nontoxic and clearly labeled











Other hazards: cleaning supplies, poisons, pesticides, flammable or corrosive materials, and pet food












Office tools and supplies





Furniture securely anchored





Blind cords secured





Tools and appliances inaccessible to children

Items smaller than 1.25" in diameter
