What's New for Cohort 2024 Portfolios – Standard 3

3.2 Self Assessment

Action steps for goals; cannot just restate indicator, goals must be specific.

Examples of 3.2

Indicator: The program invites fathers to visit the program and works to engage them in activities.

Action Steps: To achieve this goal, our program will host a “Dad and Me” event during the fall and invite them to participate in a Thanksgiving activity with their child.

3.3.1 Confidentiality Policy

Children’s information is kept confidential

Examples of 3.3.1

Sample policy:
“Information regarding children in our program will remain confidential and shall not be shared unless with required regulatory agencies.”

3.3.2 Family Conference Policy

Home visits count for family conferences

Examples of 3.3.2

Sample policies:
“Our program will hold family conferences twice per year.”

“Our program will conduct family home visits twice per year.”

3.3.3 Family Connection Opportunities to Promote Engagement and Input

Physical evidence of the activity or item, not just written policy

Examples of 3.3.3

Family Connection physical evidence examples (1 needed):
Copy of school/class newsletter, fliers or photos of family events hosted at the program, screenshot of program website.

Ongoing Family Input physical evidence examples (1 needed):
photo of program’s suggestion box, completed family survey, Parental Advisory Board meeting sign-in sheet/agenda.

Intentional Teaching Practices

Standard 4.2

- ***Lesson Plans***
 - 4.2.1: Adaptations to lesson plans as needed to meet individual children's learning needs during activities



What's New for Cohort 2024 Portfolios – Standard 4

4.2.1 Adaptations

Relate directly with an actual learning activity or lesson plan

Examples of 4.2.1

- Provide different sized crayons.
- Use multiple sized balls to roll to accommodate the 1-year-olds in the classroom.
- Provide paint brushes during fingerpainting activity.





Update #2

What to Expected for the
ERS Observations



ERS Observations

Overview of updates and changes to the number and type of ERS observations that will be conducted, and the number of children present to be eligible for observation

Observe all age groups 0-5 years

- **Observation in centers will include infants, toddlers, and preschoolers**

Resume observation of 1/3 of scale groups

- **Number of observations in centers will return to 1/3 minimum of each scale**

Minimum Enrollment

- **Reduction in number of children required to be enrolled and present on day of observation**



What's New for Cohort 2024 ERS – Age Group Observations

- Centers with infant, toddler, and preschool rooms - all three age groups will be observed
 - For observation purposes toddler rooms will be counted as any room with children aged 13 months to 35 months in any age combination
 - For observation purposes infant rooms will be counted as any room with a child enrolled under the age of 13 months, in any age combination
- Centers with 6 or more classrooms of any scale (ITERS and ECERS) - 1/3 of the classrooms assessed with that scale will be observed
 - Programs with 6 ITERS classroom (any age combination) = 2 ITERS rooms observed, 1 will automatically be an infant room if the program enrolls infants
 - Programs with 6 ECERS classrooms (any age combinations) = 2 ECERS rooms observed
- Minimum children required for observation
 - 2 children enrolled for ITERS or ECERS classrooms
 - 1 child present for ITERS classrooms

3 Application Types

- Initial
- Reapplication
- Reassessment

Minimum ERS Scores

- Adding additional cut scores for ERS averages to receive a star rating



What's New for Cohort 2024 QR Applications – New Type

Initial Application

- New to Quality Rated
- Never been rated before
- Will only ever have 1 initial application per license number

Reapplication

- Next application created after a rating has been allowed to expire
- Next application created after failing to score high enough on a rating attempt to earn a rating
- Could have multiple reapplications

Reassessment Application

- New application type created for all rerating attempts
- Can be created any time after receiving a rating
- Must be created for the expiration year if program intends to attempt a rerating to remain a rated program
- Will have multiple reassessment applications as long as program wants to remain quality rated

Pay close attention to Rating Expiration Date, create a reassessment application, select a Cohort, and submit a portfolio on time to prevent a rating expiration



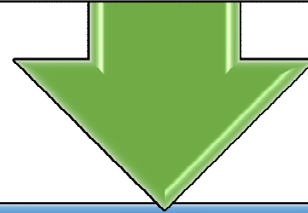
What's New for Cohort 2024 QR ERS Scoring Requirements

Current ERS Scoring Requirements

1 Star Awarded
No ERS Program Average Required

**Less than 3.0 average in any
classroom = program cannot be
rated higher than 1 star**

3 Star Awarded
ERS Program Average Required = 5.0



New ERS Scoring Requirements

1 Star Awarded
ERS Program Average = 3.0

**Less than 3.0 average in any
classroom = program cannot be
rated higher than a 1 star**

3 Star Awarded
ERS Program Average Required = 5.0





Update #4

Selecting a 2024 Cohort



What's New for Cohort 2024

- Providers due to expire in 2024 have priority to select a cohort slot from September 25, 2023 – October 22, 2023.
- Any remaining slots not accounted for by October 22, 2023, will be made available to other providers who wish to be rated in 2024.
- 634 slots available for child care learning centers (CCLC)
- 190 slots available for family child care learning homes (FCC)
- Three cohorts will be selectable in 2024.



Dedicated numbers of cohort slots each cohort for family child care learning homes and centers



Each cohort will have a two-week portfolio submission window that closes at noon



Ratings announced within 8 weeks following the last ERS observation.

IMPORTANT TO NOTE



- Cohort Slots Released to Providers with a 2024 Expiration Date: **September 25, 2023**
- Cohort Slots Released to All Other Providers: **October 23, 2023**
- A provider must have an approved application before access to the 2024 Cohort screen will be available
- Providers who were moved from 2023 cohorts to 2024 Cohort 1 will not need to select a cohort
 - These providers will see the green box containing the 2024 Cohort 1 enrollment information on their home page when they log into Quality Rated after 9/25/2023.
