

Overview

COVID-19 has made a huge impact on child food insecurity throughout Georgia. Feeding America, a nationwide network of food banks, estimates that child food insecurity has increased from 16 percent in 2018 to 23 percent in 2020. With many parents out of work, more children may be facing hunger in the months ahead – especially when schools close for summer vacation and already tight family food budgets must be stretched even further.

The **Summer Food Service Program (SFSP)** fills the hunger gap by serving nutritious meals to children 18 years and younger while school is not in session. The program is funded by the USDA, administered by the Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning (DECAL) and run by sponsoring organizations such as Boys & Girls Clubs, parks and recreation services, libraries, schools, camps, churches and local government. Approved sponsors receive a partial reimbursement for the number of meals served.

There is a critical need to recruit eligible organizations that are willing to serve healthy meals to GA's children this summer. Nonprofit organizations are encouraged to attend DECAL's free, **virtual Summer Food Service Program Summit** on Tuesday, **February 16, 2021**, at 10:00 a.m. to learn how the program works and about the responsibilities of being a sponsor.
